
- 1. Please be responsible and pick up after your terriers and yourselves. We want to be invited back!

Division A - Racing

- All terriers, including 4-6 month puppies, must be muzzled for racing.
- Basket muzzles preferred. No open-ended muzzles. No colored muzzles except white, back, tan, and clear. No Baskerville muzzles.
- Collars should be off when on deck.
- All terriers entering the catch area during a race without a secured muzzle will be disqualified.
- No request for height measurement once racing has begun.
- Terriers May Not cross-enter between Adult, Veteran and Senior Classes.

Qualifications for Championship Run Offs

- 1) A terrier MUST ENTER AN FINISH in both, at least one flat race AND one hurdle race at the beginning level based on trial entries (heat, semi, final)
- 2) A FINISHED race iw when the terrier runs down the track unassisted (by owner or anyone else) with a secured muzzle to the backside of the barrier
- 3) Terrier must place first in a flat or hurdle final to qualify for championship run offs. First to the hole is not necessarily first through the backside of the barrier
- 4) In the event a terrier does not meet all the above criteria, the second place terrier in the final of that class (either flats or hurdles will qualify for the championship run off if they meet the criteria as outlined above.

Class 45 Stud Dog and Get - Open to sire with at least two, but not more than three offspring at parent's side. Judged on Breed Standard and consistency of type. Stud dog must be an intact male; offspring may be intact or spayed/neutered.

Class 46 Brood Bitch and Produce - Open to dam with at least two, but not more than three offspring at parent's side. Judged on Breed Standard and consistency of type. Bitch must be intact; offspring may be intact or spayed/neutered. Class 47 **Best Family & Reserve** - Open to 1st and 2nd place winners in classes 45 & 46

Open to any adult JRT including those spayed and neutered. Judged on breed standard; unless otherwise noted.

- Class 89 Neutered/Spayed Working Terrier Open to any adult Spayed/Neutered Jack Russell Terrier which holds a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate
- Class 90 Neutered/Spayed Terrier Open to adult neutered/spayed terrier

- Class 92 Veteran Dog Open to any dog six years and older.

(One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re - enter until quarry is reached; mark quarry for 15 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

Class 102 Novice Puppy - Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Puppy Class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; when quarry is reached must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another (examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)

Class 103 Open Puppy - Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship GTG class at this trial. (1 second per total feet of tunnel; may leave earth and re-enter once before quarry is reached; work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.) Puppies receiving a 100% score in Open Puppy Class may compete in that class again in the future. **Open Puppy GTG is not open to any Puppy which has competed in Puppy Championship GTG.**

Class 104 **Puppy Championship** - Open to Jack Russells, 6 up to 12 months which have earned 100% in an Open Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. A copy of a 100% Open score sheet shall be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Puppy Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. (One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter, before quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. May switch from one type of work to another.)

Class 105 Novice Adult - Open to Jack Russells one year of age or older which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open class at this trial. (One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry.)

Class 106 Open Adult - Open to Jack Russells one year or older which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. (One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry.)

Class 107 Just for Fun GTG - Non Sanctioned - Open to any adult JRT 10" and under. Terrier may not cross enter into any other division or class. The same rules apply as Class 106 Open Adult.

Certificate Classes: Open to any adult Jack Russell one year and over, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. (One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter, <u>before quarry is reached</u>; must work quarry continuously for 1 full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. May switch from one type of work to another.)

May switch from one type of work to another. Puppies receiving a 100% score in Open Puppy Super Earth Class may compete in that class again in the future. Open Puppy Super Earth is not open to any Puppy which has competed in Puppy Championship GTG.

Open to Jack Russell Puppies, 6-12 months which have scored 100% in the Open Super Earth class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. A copy of a 100% score sheet shall be submitted with pre-entry or shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Puppy Go-to-Ground Champion and Reserve. One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter, <u>before quarry is reached</u>; must work quarry continuously for 1 full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. May switch from one type of work to another.

Certificate Classes: Open to Jack Russell Terriers, one year and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and Second Place winners will be Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

- Please list class number, youth's name, birthday, and dog's name on the entry form.
- The Youth Handler must handle the same adult terrier in all Youth Division classes entered. No puppies please.
- Child/Youth exhibitor's age is determined as of January 1st of the calendar year, except for those children turning 5 years of age. They may start competing in Child Handler any time of the year following their 5th birthday.
- Child/Youth entries must be JRTCA members either under a family membership or under an individual Youth membership.
- Entry fee is \$5.00 class. Quality of the dog is NOT to be considered.
- Points are: 1st=8 pts., 2nd=6 pts., 3rd=5 pts., 4th= 4 pts., 5th=3 pts., 6th= 2 pts., & Participation=1 pt.

Class 127 Child Handler

Open to any youth aged 5 thru 9, handling a Jack Russell Terrier, six months or older. This class is offered as an introductory experience in handling and learning about the JRT. Judged on the child's ability to present his/her dog and beginning knowledge of the JRT. Quality of the dog NOT to be considered.

Class 128 Youth Handler

Open to any youth aged 10 thru 16, handling a Jack Russell Terrier, six months or older. This class is offered as an introductory experience in handling and learning about the JRT. Judged on the child's ability to present his/her dog and beginning knowledge of the JRT. Quality of the dog NOT to be considered.

NOTE: Terrier must run in its competition class, if entered, before being used by child or youth for G-T-G.

Class 129 Child Handler GTG - **Non Sanctioned** Open to any youth aged 5 thru 9, handling an **adult** Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of GTG. To be run through the 10 foot Novice tunnel. Time not to be considered.

Class 130 Youth GTG - Open to any youth aged 10 thru 16, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of GTG. To be run through the 10 foot Novice liner; time not considered.

Class 131: Youth Handler High Score and Reserve - a Youth High Score Perpetual will be awarded to the Champion on Sunday. Awarded to the highest scoring youth and runner-up in classes 128 and 130.

1st = 8 pts, 2nd = 6 pts, 3rd = 5 pts, 4th = 4 pts, 5th = 3 pts, 6th = 2 pts, Participation = 1 pt.

Non-Sanctioned Events - Events must be paid at registration booth day of trial. Money will not be taken at the events except for GTG move ups.

Division G - Lure Coursing

This is a timed event with terrier chasing the lure. Fastest time of the two runs qualifies for ribbons 1st-6th. Championship ties will be broken by the terrier's second lure coursing time.

Class 139 Puppies 6-12 months 10" up to 12½"

Class 140 Puppies 6-12 months over 12½" up to 15"

Class 141 Just for Fun Dogs/Bitches under 10" May not cross enter.

Class 142 Adults 1 year and older, 10" up to 12%"

Class 143 Adults 1 year and older, over 12½" up to 15"

Class 144 Veterans 6 years and older, 10" up to 12½"

Class 145 Veterans 6 years and older, over 12½" up to 15"

Class 146 Seniors 9 years and older, 10" up to 12%"

Class 147 Seniors 9 years and older, over 12½" up to 15"

Class 148 10" up to 12½" Lure Coursing Champion and Reserve - fastest times of the day

Class 149 Over 12½" up to 15"Over Lure Coursing Champion and Reserve - fastest times of the day





Division H - Barn Hunt

- Can your terrier find the guarry? Time starts when the handler releases the terrier in the brush area.
- After one minute, handler may assist the terrier in locating the quarry.
- JUDGE determines when the terrier locates and or works the guarry.

Class 150: Puppies, 6 to 12 months

Class 151: Adults, 10" up to 12 1/2"

Class 152: Adults, over 12 1/2" up to 15"

Class 153: Veterans, 10" up to 12 1/2"

Class 154: Veterans, Over 12 ½" up to 15"

Class 155: Seniors, 10" up to 12 1/2", Open to terriers 9 years and older

Class 156: Seniors, over 12 1/2" up to 15". Open to terriers 9 years and older

Class 157: Barn Hunt Champion and Reserve Will be determined by 1st and 2nd fastest times of the day.

Division I - TNT Tunnel Adventure

This is a timed event/competition with the terrier working its way through a tunnel maze that may have dead ends and obstacles to maneuver. The tunnel has a clear side so you can see the progress of your terrier as it makes its way to the caged quarry. The terrier runs the tunnel twice; the best time is the final time that counts towards placement. **TNT Tunnel will be awarding a special prize for the OVERALL FASTEST TIME OF THE WEEKEND.**

Class 158: Puppies, 4 months up to 12 months.

Class 159: Adults up to 6 years

Class 160: Veterans 6+ years

Class 161: Seniors 9+ years

Class 162: TNT Champion and Reserve Will be determined by

1st and 2nd fastest times of the day.



Division J - Ball Toss

SATURDAY ONLY- 1:00 to 3:30

Ball toss is a timed event. Three (3) tosses with the best time recorded. Ball is tossed a specific distance; dog must retrieve the ball back over the start/finish line with each toss/retrieval timed. A variety of balls will be provided, or you may use your dog's "favorite" ball.

Class 165: Adult, 1 year and older, Over 12 ½" up to 15"

VJRTC

- 1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
- 2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members and must not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT organization. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records.
- 3. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter. Entries must be within the 10-15: JFTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10: height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
- 4. Puppies (under 12 months) are not eligible for championship in any division but heir own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (i.e. not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
- 5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season will be refunded with a veterinarian certificate or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Administrator.
- 6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Family, Open or Working Conformation.
- A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under that Judge in the Conformation division.
- 8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson or any member of their household may not be entered in any phase of the competition with the exception of Child and Youth Handling.
- Terriers owned by judges may not be entered in any division in which they are judging but may enter the competition in any other division.
- 10. Terriers owned by stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
- 11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier entered in any class number may be made only by another exhibitor in that same class number or by the Judge EXCEPT in Racing. Requests for the measurement of a terrier in Racing may be made by the Judge or by an exhibitor with a terrier entered in the same class number; OR, if classes are split by gender, may call for a measurement of a terrier of the opposite gender in the same age and height category. (Example: The owner of an under adult dog entered in Racing may call for the measurement of an under adult bitch as the potential exists for them to race each other in the Championship Races.) Exhibitors racing puppies may call for the measurement of a puppy in a different age category as long as it is in the same height category. The person making the request for measurement must name the terrier or terriers they wish to have measured, but requests for measurement of the entire class will not be honored. The measurement of the terrier will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial. Only JRTCA height cards issues after September 1999 will be honored.
- 12. Excessive use of squeaky or fun-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the Conformation ring and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at the Judge's discretion.
- 13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier Classes or Certificate Go-To-Ground must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the ring/den steward at the time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC certificate signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
- 14. Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered and asked to leave the trial site. This applies to RV's and Campers, if at same address as the trial grounds.
- 15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off-leash work. No liberty leashes allowed.
- 16. Overly aggressive dogs or an owner's failure to control his/her dog may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the Trial Administrator.
- 17. The abuse or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded.
- 18. Dogs other than JRTs on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Administrator.
- 19. Exhibitors are responsible to double check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
- 20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be obtained by contacting the JRTCA office (410-561-3655) or it can be downloaded from the JRTCA website (www.terrier.com)
- 21. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties, which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their sole and absolute discretion.
- 22. All dogs brought to JRTCA Sanctioned Trials must be current on vaccinations. No dogs of any age may be brought to a trial who have suspicion of contagious or infectious disease.
- 23. THE JUDGE'S DECISION CONCERING PLACEMENTS ARE FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS!
